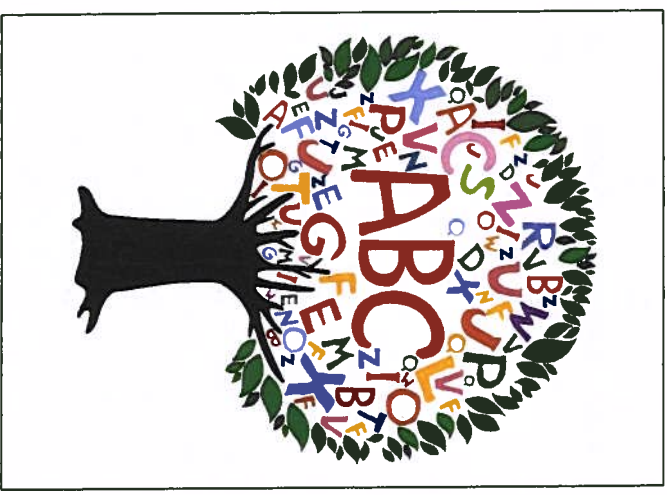

Program Goals and Description

The program goal is to provide students with the necessary skills [language acquisition and social skills] for placement into a regular and traditional classroom environment.

The program is centered on helping students that need assistance in acquiring English language skills and/or socialization to assimilate into a regular classroom setting.

The class will focus on building English language skills by introducing and familiarizing students with phonics and phonemic awareness, vocabulary development and comprehension, letter to sound correspondence, recognizing environmental print, communicating in full and appropriate sentences and more.

Socialization and behavioral skills will be developed through activities which incorporate listening to and following single and multi-step directives, following simple routines, sharing, taking turns, participating in learning time activities and more in a setting where students will directly interact with peers and teachers through cooperative play, peer-modeling instruction, team building and group-learning activities.

Program Session FAQ's

- The program session runs from February 1st through April 30th
- Classroom session meets daily Monday through Friday on regularly scheduled school days (see school calendar for dates class is not in session)
- Class time Arrival 12:30 PM
Dismissal 2:45 PM
