Active participation with other members of the teaching team in the implementation of curriculum, parent communication, and quality interactions with children. Performing documentation, anecdotal records, and daily sheets (when applicable). Maintaining a safe, clean and organized classroom environment. Demonstrating kindness, creativity and love for God and all children.

### Qualifications

Passion for the care and education of children, Previous child care experience (preferred), Evidence of Christian maturity (demonstrated in attitude, action, and speech), Dependable to work scheduled hours.

### Requirements

- For Cub Care (Pre-School, Pre K, Alt. K) teaching positions, a minimum of an associate's degree is preferred but not necessary. A high school degree is required for substitutes.

- For Tiger Care (K-6) after school care, applicants must be 18 years of age.
- Applicants must be willing to undergo a background check, in accordance with local law/regulations.
- Upon hire, employee must provide; Copy of diploma(s), educator license (if applicable), medical statement, complete CPR/First Aid and AED Certification training, 15 hours of Professional Development, including Communicable Disease and Child Abuse Recognition and Prevention training.
